Dear Oakleigh Grammar Parents

RE: School Operations for Term Four 2020

As you are aware, following an announcement from our Premier regarding the roadmap to reopening our economy, our School will continue to provide Remote Learning until the end of this term. I wish to advise School operations for the commencement of Term Four:

- **Tuesday 6 to Friday 9 October – first week of Term Four**

Our School will continue to provide Remote Learning for the first week of Term Four, with the following exceptions:

- Due to critical Arrowsmith Program Assessments, on-Campus learning will commence from Tuesday 6 October for all Arrowsmith Students. The Homework Club will combine into the regular day through consolidated learning until the regular Program resumes.
- Our ELC will operate on-Campus from Tuesday 6 October for all ELC Students. Please note the School Holiday Program will only operate for students who have been supervised on-Campus during the Stage 4 Lockdown period.
- As the General Assessment Test GAT has been confirmed to be held on Wednesday 7 October 2020, our VCE Unit 3 / 4 Students undertaking the GAT will be required to be on Campus on this day.
- On Campus Supervision will continue as scheduled for all students previously authorised during the Stage 4 Lockdown period.

- **From Monday 12 October until further notice**

Students in Prep to Year 2 and Years 11 and 12 will return to on-Campus learning.

- Students in Year 10 will return to on-Campus learning every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, due to VCE and equity of learning. Every Monday and Friday Year 10 will continue with Remote Learning at home, with the exception of Year 10 Arrowsmith students who will remain at School on these days.
- On Campus Supervision will continue as scheduled for all students previously authorised during the Stage 4 Lockdown period.
- Remote Learning will continue for all students in Years 3 to 9.

Our Canteen will resume operations on Monday 12 October.

These arrangements are subject to the advice of the Victorian Chief Medical Health Officer communicated to us via the Premier's office.

Next week, you will receive further communications from relevant personnel pertaining to bus operations, pick up and drop off times, Second Hand Uniform Shop and Dobson's opening times and relevant information specific to each sub-School.
